MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE NO. 2024-02-500

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING ADDITIONAL GUIDELINES FOR SAFE SPACES ACT IN THE MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE NO. 2017-05-413, OTHERWISE KNOWN AS THE MODIFIED GAD CODE OF DUMALINAO, TO PREVENT THE OCCURRENCE OF GENDER-BASED SEXUAL HARASSMENT IN STREETS AND PUBLIC SPACES, ONLINE, IN WORKPLACES, AND EDUCATIONAL AND TRAINING INSTITUTIONS IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF DUMALINAO, ZAMBOANGA DEL SUR, AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS FOR THE PURPOSE THEREOF.

Modified GAD Code of Dumalinao, providing additional provision of Safe Spaces Act to prevent the occurrence of gender-based sexual harassment in streets and public spaces, online, in workplaces and in educational and training institutions in the Municipality of Dumalinao, Zamboanga del Sur, and appropriating funds for the purpose thereof;

WHEREAS, Republic Act No. 11313, otherwise known as the "Safe Spaces Act" which provides a policy of the State to value the dignity of every human person and guarantee full respect for human rights;

WHEREAS, certain behavior among our people such as catcalling, wolf-whistling, unwanted sexual innuendo during normal conversations, and such other actions that are done in our streets and other public places which we have taken for granted and treated as "normal" behavior, should stop as these are affronts to the dignity of persons they are directed at;

WHEREAS, these unwanted and uninvited sexual actions or remarks against any person should not be tolerated as they are not appropriate in a society where respect and decency should be the norms and not the exception;

WHEREAS, the Safe Spaces Act, which defines and penalizes gender-based sexual harassment in streets and public places, online, workplaces and educational training institutions, also stipulates that it is the duty of local government units to pass their respective ordinances to effect its localization;


WHEREAS, after careful review and exhaustive deliberation, and after finding the same to be proper and order;

NOW, THEREFORE, on motion by **HON. MA. GEMMA C. ALBISO** and severally seconded by the august body;

BE IT ORDAINED by the 12th Sangguniang Bayan of Dumalinao, Zamboanga del Sur, in session assembled that:


SECTION I. SHORT TITLE. This Ordinance shall be known as the "The GAD Code-Safe Spaces Act of the Municipality of Dumalinao."

SECTION II. PURPOSE. This Ordinance is enacted to incorporate in the Municipal GAD Code of the locality and implement the primary responsibilities of the LGU-Dumalinao in enforcing the pertinent provisions of Republic Act No. 11313 or the Safe Spaces Act and to provide measures to prevent the occurrence of gender-based sexual harassment in the locality. It also aims to assure and ensure the protection of the people from gender-based sexual harassment as it seeks to inculcate among its populace respect for each other.



SECTION III. DEFINITION OF TERMS. The following terms as used in this Ordinance shall be defined as follows:

- a. Catcalling refers to unwanted remarks directed towards a person, commonly done in the form of wolf-whistling and misogynistic, trans phobic, homophobic, and sexist slurs.
- b. Employee refers to a person, who in exchange for remuneration, agrees to perform specified services for another person, whether natural or juridical, and whether private or public, who exercises fundamental control over the work, regardless of the term or duration of agreement: Provided, That for the purposes of this law, a person who is detailed to an entity under a subcontracting or secondment agreement shall be considered an employee.
- c. Employer refers to a person who exercises control over an employee: Provided, That for the purpose of this Act, the status or conditions of the latter's employment or engagement shall be disregarded.
- d. Gender refers to a set of socially ascribed characteristics, norms, roles, attitudes, values and expectations identifying the social behavior of men and women, and the relations between them.
- e. Gender-based sexual harassment refers to offenses defined and penalized under Republic Act No. 11313, otherwise known as the "Safe Spaces Act" which may be committed in streets and public places, online, in the workplace and in educational and training institution.
- **SECTION IV. GENDER-BASED SEXUAL HARASSMENT PREVENTION.** The LGU-Dumalinao shall ensure the protection of its constituents from gender-based sexual harassment offenses as defined and penalized under Republic Act No. 11313 otherwise known as the Safe Spaces Act through the implementation of a comprehensive and sustainable program to prevent and respond to such offenses.
- SECTION V. EDUCATION AND AWARENESS CAMPAIGN. The Municipal Social Welfare and Development Office/ GAD focal person shall take the lead in the local education and awareness campaign of Republic Act No. 11313 and this ordinance. Pursuant to this mandate, it shall undertake the following:
- a. Develop a training module that will be used in conducting capacity building and training activities for local government personnel tasked to enforce and implement this Ordinance. The module shall be developed in consultation with women, business establishments, labor organizations, LGBTQ+ organizations, civil society organizations (CSOs) and other stakeholders.



- b. Develop a pool of trainers who shall conduct capacity building or training orientations.
- c. Develop and produce, in cooperation with the Local School Board (LSB) and the Public Information Officer, information education and communication (IEC) materials that will raise the public's awareness on gender-based sexual harassment, inform the public about the prohibited acts and penalties for committing the same and promote the reporting and referral mechanisms and hotline numbers as provided under this Ordinance. The IEC materials shall be in print, such as leaflets, posters and stickers, among others, accessible through broadcast and social media platforms and must be in the local dialect.

Every barangay in the locality, through its ASH/VAWC Desk shall produce, distribute and post in conspicuous places copies of the IEC materials mentioned above, including copies of the Safe Spaces Act and pertinent laws protecting women, girls, and persons of diverse sexual orientations and gender identities and expressions against violence and discrimination.

- d. Take the lead in facilitating or ensuring that designated ASHEs are equipped with the required capacities.
- e. Take the lead in implementing initiatives developed by the Philippine Commission on Women (PCW) and the Department of the Interior and Local Government (DILG) in raising national awareness and such other responsibilities that may, be identified by the PCW and DILG.
- SECTION VI. ANTI-SEXUAL HARASSMENT ENFORCERS (ASHEs). Barangay Officials, Tanods, and authorized enforcers shall be deputized as Anti-Sexual Harassment Enforcers (ASHEs). They shall have the following functions:
- a. Immediately apprehend persons committing sexual harassment on the streets, in accordance with the applicable rules on arrests, with the duly to bring them to the nearest Philippine National Police (PNP) station;
- b. Receive complaints of sexual harassment and immediately refer the same to the proper authorities;
- c. Keep a ledge of offenders together with the women's and children's desk of PNP stations; and
- d. Assist the MPS-Dumalinao in the exercise of its functions under the Safe Spaces Act.


SECTION VII. REFERRAL AND SUPPORT MECHANISM. The following referral and support mechanism shall be pursued to achieve the purpose of this Ordinance:

- a. Anti-Sexual Harassment Desk the LGU-Dumalinao shall establish an Anti-Sexual Harassment (ASH) Desk for purposes of expediting the receipt and processing of complaints and reports of sexual harassment in the locality. The ASH Desk shall have the following functions:
- Receive, document, and respond to complaints and reports of sexual harassment;
- Facilitate the referral of cases and persons to the appropriate public and private service providers for legal, medical, psychosocial, safety, security, and other services;
- 3. Record the number of sexual harassment cases received and referred and submit a quarterly report to the municipal DILG Office;
- 4. Keep case records confidential and secure and ensure that only authorized personnel have access to these records; and
- Assist in the formulation and update of local policies and mechanisms, as well as educational and awareness campaigns, in addressing genderbased sexual harassment.

The Barangay VAWC Desk shall concurrently serve as Anti-Sexual Harassment (ASH) Desks for purposes of expediting the receipt and processing of complaints and reports of gender-based sexual harassment in the barangays.

- b. ASH Committee An ASH Committee within the Technical Working Group (TWG) of the LGU-Dumalinao GAD Focal Point System is hereby created to supervise, support, and responsible for the operations of the ASH Desk in the locality. The ASH Committee shall be composed of representatives from:
 - 1. MSWDO:
 - 2. MPS-Dumalinao;
 - Office of the LIGA ng mga Barangay;
 - 4. CSOs actively working on issues affecting women; and
 - 5. CSOs actively working on issues affecting LGBT persons.
- c. ASH Desk Officer The LGU-Dumalinao shall designate an ASH Desk Officer who shall possess attitudes that show empathy and understanding of the victim-survivor and committed to keep the confidentiality of cases. The ASH




Desk Officer, who shall preferably be a woman, shall have the following qualifications:

- 1. Trained to be gender-responsive and gender-sensitive knowledgeable about gender-based violence and the different forms of sexual harassment, and oriented on gender equality and the diversity of sexual orientations and gender identities and expressions;
- 2. Trained to handle cases of gender-based violence and sensitive to the needs of victims-survivor and complaints in each possible scenario;
- 3. Familiar with cases that may be brought to the ASH Desk that could be covered by other laws, including but not limited to the following:
 - i. Anti-Sexual Harassment Act (R.A. No. 7877);
 - ii. Anti-Violence Against Women and Their Children Act (R.A. No. 9262);
 - iii. Anti-Photo and Video Voyeurism Act (R.A. No. 9995);
 - iv. Anti-Child Pornography Act (R.A. No. 9775);
- v. Special/ Protection of Children Against Abuse, Exploitation, and Discrimination Act (R.A. No.7610);
 - vi. Anti-Trafficking in Persons Act (R.A. No. 9208);
- vii. Provisions of the Revised Penal Code which are related to genderbased violence; and
 - viii. Relevant provisions of the Family Code.
- 4. Well-informed about all the remedies provided for under the law, as well as the services of the LGU-Dumalinao and those provided under the ASH Referral Network.

The VAWC Desk within the locality shall concurrently serve as ASH Desk Officers. The LGU-Dumalinao shall undertake measures that are designated to capacitate VAWC Desk Persons to effectively perform their duties and responsibilities as concurrent ASH Desk Officers.

- d. Anti-Sexual Harassment Hotline The LGU-Dumalinao shall assigned emergency HOTLINE as serve as the ASH Hotline under this Ordinance to accept calls only on matters/complaints provided in this ordinance:
 - 1. The hotline shall have the following functions:



- Receive complaints, reports, and inquiries involving sexual harassment through the Emergency Hotline and respond to urgent situations as necessary;
- ii. Facilitate the referral of cases and persons to the appropriate public and private service providers of legal, medical, psychosocial, safety, security, and other services;
- iii. Respond to questions related to the Safe Spaces Act and other related laws, ordinances, rules, and regulations;
- iv. Inform victims and complainants of the remedies available to them under the law;
- v. Record, maintain, monitor, and update a database of complaints, reports, and inquiries conveyed through the assigned Emergency Hotlines; and
 - vi. Perform other related functions as may be assigned.

Written records and audio recordings of complaints, reports, and inquiries involving sexual harassment shall be preserved and kept confidential and secure at all time. Such records shall be preserved in accordance with existing laws, rules and regulations on the matter. As such, the responders shall ensure that no use, viewing, copying, disclosure or publication of such written records shall be made unless, the same is ordered by the court or other body with competent jurisdiction and regular information dissemination of the Anti-Sexual Harassment Hotline shall be made in every barangay, public and private offices, establishments and schools within the locality.

e. ASH Referral Network – the Municipal Mayor shall within thirty (30) days after the effectivity of this Ordinance, convene the ASH committee of the LGU-Dumalinao GAD Focal Point System to take the lead in the creation of the ASH Referral Network which must be in full operation within sixty (60) days from the time the ASH Subcommittee is convened. The ASH Referral Network shall serve to strengthen the coordination and collaboration between and among agencies, offices, NGOs/CSOs and private groups at the local level in providing comprehensive services that will prevent and respond to sexual harassment cases and address the needs of the victim-survivor.

It shall provide services encompassing the medical/health, psychological, social, economic, legal, and spiritual needs of the victim-survivor. As such, the referral network shall be composed of representative from the following:

- 1. VAWC/ASH Desk of every barangay in the locality;
- Municipal Health Office;

- 3. MSWDO;
- 4. MPS-Dumalinao Women and Children Desk;
- 5. Office of the Provincial Prosecutor or the Public Attorney's Office; and
- 6. Non-government organization (NGOs) or civil society organizations (CSOs) involved in gended equality and human rights and those providing medical, psycho-social, economic, legal, and social services.

A focal person shall be designated, respectively, by each of these offices, agencies and organizations. The focal person shall be responsible for the processing of referrals made to them and efficiently providing the appropriate service/s needed.

f. Memorandum of Agreement. - A Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) shall be entered into between the LGU-Dumalinao, through the Municipal Mayor, and the service providers in the referral network, stating therein the protocols and procedures to be observed in facilitating the receipt, documentation, response and referral of complaints and reports of all forms of sexual harassment including their specific roles and responsibilities under the referral system.

The ASH committee shall convene and facilitate stakeholders, meetings or workshops to map-out and identify relevant resources and services available in the community and develop the protocols and procedures of the referral network.

SECTION VIII. KATARUNGAN PAMBARANGAY. Any deputized ASH who receives a complaint for sexual harassment shall only refer the complaint to the Lupong Tagapamayapa if the same falls strictly within the coverage of the Katarungang Pambarangay.

- a. The following cases of gender-based sexual harassment are not covered by the Katarungang Pambarangay and shall be referred to the local PNP/MPS Dumalinao women and children's desk or to the proper officer or court for appropriate action:
 - i. Offenses under the Anti-Sexual Harassment Act of 1995;
- ii. Offenses under the Safe Spaces Act, other than the first and second offenses in Section 11 (a) of the Act;
- iii. Offenses under the Anti-Violence Against Women and their Children Act, the Anti-Photo and Video Voyeurism Act, the Anti-Child pornography Act,

the Special Protection of Children Against Abuse, Exploitation, and Discrimination Act, and the Anti-Trafficking in persons Act;

- iv. Violations of ordinances punishable by, imprisonment exceeding one year months or a fine exceeding P5, 000.00;
- v. Where one party is a public officer or employee, and the dispute relates to the performance of his official functions;
- vi. Disputes involving parties who actually reside in barangays of different cities or municipalities, except where such barangay units adjoin each other and the parties thereto agree to submit their differences to amicable settlement by an appropriate Lupon; and
- vii. Other cases not covered by the Katarungang Pambarangay under the Local Government Code and other relevant laws, rules, and regulations.
- b. Parties to a gender-based sexual harassment case may opt to go directly to court in the following instances:
 - i. Where the accused is under detention:
- ii. Where a person has otherwise been deprived of personal liberty calling for habeas corpus proceedings;
- iii. Where actions are coupled with provisional remedies such as preliminary injunction, attachment, delivery of personal property and support pendente lite; and
- iv. Where the action may otherwise be barred by the, statute of limitation.

SECTION IX. THE CCTV CAMERAS OF DUMALINAO. To aid in the filing of cases and gathering of evidence, the CCTV Cameras of the Municipality of Dumalinao shall:

- a. Keep the daily video recording with a digital format and preserve the same for a period consistent with the provisions of existing laws, rules and regulations on the matter for the purpose of providing surveillance in the service of law enforcement and crime prevention within the municipality. After such period, the data shall be deleted;
- b. Maintain the confidentiality of the video feeds and recordings obtained. The LDRRMO/authorized personnel shall ensure that no use, viewing, copying, disclosure or publication of the video feeds and recordings shall be made except for purposes mentioned in the preceding paragraph and for

other legitimate purposes it may serve upon written order of any court or body with competent jurisdiction; and

- c. Encourage all barangays within the locality to install and operate a CCTV system in roads, public streets, alleys and sidewalks within their respective territorial jurisdictions.
- **SECTION X. REHABILITATION PROGRAM.** For purposes of implementing the rehabilitation program of offenders of the Safe Spaces Act, the Municipal Social Welfare and Development Office, in partnership with the Gender and Development (GAD) council/focal person shall:
- a. Formulate a rehabilitation program that will help an offender develop gender sensitivity and respect for human rights, instill civic consciousness and contribute to the improvement of a public work or promotion of public service;
- b. Conduct a case study of the offender to determine the appropriate program to be performed under the rehabilitation program and endorse the same to the VAWC/ASH Desk of the barangay where the rehabilitation program shall be undertaken for coordination and assistance;
- c. Provide a gender sensitivity seminar to be conducted by the MSWDO/GAD focal person and other relevant offices of the LGU-Dumalinao;
- d. Supervise and evaluate the conduct of the rehabilitation program; and
- e. The Municipal Social Welfare and Development Office shall prepare a final case report with recommendations which shall be endorsed to the MPS-Dumalinao. The final case report may be used as basis in the issuance of certificate of completion mandated under DILG-PCW JMC No. 2020-001.

SECTION XI. GENDER SENSITIVITY ORIENTATION FOR TRICYCLE, BAO-BAO, AND MOTORIZED DRIVERS AND OPERATORS. The MSWDO/GAD Focal Person shall conduct seminars for tricycle, bao-bao, and motorized drivers and operators to orient them on gender sensitivity and pertinent laws protecting women, girls, and persons of diverse sexual orientations and gender identities and expressions against violence and discrimination shall be required. Stickers and/or certificates shall be issued to tricycle, bao-bao and motorized drivers or operators who have undergone such seminars.

SECTION XII. COMPLIANCE OF EDUCATIONAL AND TRAINING INSTITUTIONS. The LGU-Dumalinao shall ensure the compliance of ail education and training institutions within its jurisdiction on the provisions of Section 21 of Republic Act No. 11313. All education and training institutions shall within sixty (60) days upon the effectivity of this Ordinance, submit to the MSWDO/GAD Focal Person a


written communication attesting to its compliance of the provisions of Section 21 of RA 11313 and all documents related thereto.

SECTION XIII. DESIGNATION OF ANTI-SEXUAL HARASSMENT OFFICER IN PRIVATE ESTABLISHMENT (ASHO). All private establishments in the municipality shall provide a safe and gender-sensitive environment for their employees. Private establishments with at least thirty (30) employees may designate at least one (1) Anti-Sexual Harassment Officer (ASHO) who shall perform the functions enumerated hereunder:

- a. Receive complaints of sexual harassment committed within their premises and accompany victims to the nearest medical facility, when immediate medical attention is needed;
- b. Provide appropriate assistance to victims of gender-based sexual harassment, such as assessing the risk and immediate need of the victim, coordinating with local police authorities immediately after gender-based sexual harassment is reported and accompanying the victim to other agencies which can provide the necessary assistance. Toward this end, the ASHE shall:
- 1. Preserve evidence related to any complaint or report of genderbased sexual harassment, including CCTV footage, and provide access to the same when so ordered by the appropriate authorities;
- 2. Ensure that the establishment is a safe and gender-sensitive environment to encourage victims to report gender-based sexual harassment as soon as it happens. This may be done by:
- i. Maintaining, within the establishment, a secure and private area where the victim can narrate the relevant events and, whenever possible, provide an online platform for reporting gender-based sexual harassment; and

ii. Installing, posting and maintaining in the business establishment clearly visible warning signs against gender-based sexual harassment, including the anti-sexual harassment hotline number(s) of the municipality and the contact number of the nearest police station, in bold letters: Provided, that the warning signs must be readable, written in a language that is understandable by customers, and placed in a conspicuous area within the vicinity of the establishment.

The MSWDO/GAD Focal Person provide an orientation seminar for ASHOs to equip them with the necessary knowledge to be able to perform their functions. It shall also develop a system that shall ensure that reports and/or complaints of gender-based sexual harassment committed in these establishments are addressed and reported by ASHOs in an efficient and effective manner.



SECTION XIV. ASSISTANCE TO EMPLOYER IN THE DEVELOPMENT OF A CODE OF CONDUCT AND IN THE FORMATION OF A COMMITTEE ON DECORUM AND INVESTIGATION. The LGU-Dumalinao GAD Focal Point System shall extend its services to employers both from the public and private sector as well as heads of educational and training institutions who shall seek assistance in the development of a Code of Conduct and in the formation of a Committee on Decorum and Investigation (CODI) as provided under Rule VIII, Sections 32 and 33 of the Implementing Rules and Regulations of Republic Act No. 11313. For this purpose, it shall train and develop a pool of resource persons to carry out this mandated task.


SECTION XV. ASSITANCE TO VICTIMS OF ONLINE SEXUAL HARASSMENT. The MSWDO/ GAD Focal Person shall create a secure electronic mail (e-mail) address or portal in the official website of the LGU-Dumalinao where online sexual harassment complaints may be received, documented and subsequently referred to the PNP, Anti-Cybercrime Group (PNP). Such email address or portal shall only be accessible to an anti-sexual harassment enforcer so designated for this purpose, for the protection of the victims and to maintain the confidentially of cases.

SECTION XVI. REPORTING. Pursuant to the required initial reporting under DILG PCW JMC No. 2020-01, the ASH Desk Officer shall, within sixty (60) days from the effectivity of this Ordinance, prepare the following documents and submit them to the municipal office of the DILG:

- a. A list and copies of all ordinances, resolutions, and local issuances related to sexual harassment; and
- b. A description of the projects, activities, and programs undertaken by the LGU-Dumalinao to comply with its duties and responsibilities under the Safe Spaces Act and these Guidelines.


SECTION XVII. SAFETY AUDIT. The LGU-Dumalinao shall regularly prepare and submit every semester, the Safety Implementation Reports (SIRs) and Safety Audit Reports (SARs) required under the safety audit under DILG PCW JMC No. 2020-01 to the Committee on Anti-Trafficking and VAWC (RCAT-VAWC).

- a. Indicators The ASH Desk Officer shall keep a record and documentation of the following data identified as indicators to be incorporated in the SIRs and SARs:
- i. Number of complaints for sexual harassment received by local PNP offices, ASHEs, ASHOs in private establishments, local ASH Desks, and local ASH Hotlines, and the actions taken thereon;



- ii. Number of persons detained and number of persons apprehended for sexual harassment, categorized into arrests based on warrants and warrantless arrests;
- iii. Number of persons who attended gender sensitivity seminars after being found guilty of the crime of gender-based streets and public spaces sexual harassment;
- iv. Number of sexual harassment cases referred to the Lupong Tagapamayapa;
 - v. Number of ASHEs in proportion to local population;
- vi. Number of private establishments accessible to the public and number of those which have installed warning signs, designated ASHOs, installed CCTV cameras, and developed protocols to address gender-based sexual harassment;
- vii. List of locations were copies of the Safe Spaces Act and its counterpart ordinances are posted;
- viii. List of locations of CCTV cameras in the municipality and in the barangays;
- ix. List of roads, alleys, and sidewalks and portions thereof which are not covered by CCTV cameras;
 - x. Existence of ASH Hotlines;
- xi. List of ASH Desks in the locality and list of barangays with and without ASH Desks;
- xii. Number of requests for psychological counselling received by LGUs and the actions taken thereon; and
 - xiii. Other relevant indicators as may be required by the DILG.
- b. Barangay Safety Audits the LGU-Dumalinao through the MSWDO/GAD Focal Person shall conduct a safety audit of all barangays within its jurisdiction using the same indicators enumerated in the preceding section. The SIRs and SARs shall thereafter be submitted to the RCAT-VAWCon or before every 15th of January and July of the following year.

SECTION XIII. MULTI-SECTORAL PARTICIPATION. In the conduct of safety audits and the preparation of SIRs and SARs, the Barangay Gender Focal Point System



and the MSWDO/GAD Focal Person shall involve the participation of representatives from the following:

- a. Department of Education or schools within the locality;
- b. Private business establishments;
- c. MPS-Dumalinao; and
- d. CSOs actively working on issues affecting women and LGBT persons, especially on gender-based violence.

SECTION XIX. ADMINISTRATIVE LIABILITY. Any municipal official or employee tasked to perform specific functions under this Ordinance who shall fail or refuse, without any justifiable reason, to perform such functions, shall be administratively liable.

SECTION XX. APPLICABILITY OF PENALTY/IES IMPOSED BY THE NATIONAL LAW. The penalty/ies imposed for the infraction of the provision/s of RA 11313 shall likewise be the imposable penalty/ies for violation of this ordinance.

SECTION XXI. FUNDING. All mechanisms, awareness campaigns, training activities, and other related initiatives under this Ordinance, including the establishment and operation of ASH Desks and hotlines, shall be appropriated from GAD Fund and the local development fund of the locality and the barangays.

SECTION XXII. REPEALING CLAUSE. All ordinances, resolutions, memorandum, circulars, rules and regulations inconsistent with the provisions of this Code are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.

SECTION XXIII. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE. If for any reason, any section or provision of this Ordinance is declared unconstitutional or invalid, the other sections or provisions hereof which are not affected shall continue to be in full force and effect.

SECTION XXIV. EFFECTIVITY. This Ordinance shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its posting in three (3) conspicuous places within the municipality.

Balandra presented the proposed ordinance enacting the Municipal Code pursuing a Public- Private Partnership for the people initiative for Local Government Unit (LGU P4) approach towards developments, providing for the procedure for the selecting the private sector proponent adopting a contract management framework and providing appropriation and for other purposes and discussed the important features and purpose of the ordinance that seeks to foster collaboration between the public and private sectors to drive sustainable development and address community needs.

- 2. Hon. Ma. Gemma C. Albiso presented the proposed ordinance providing an additional guidelines of Safe Spaces Act in the Municipal Ordinance No. 2017-05-413, otherwise known as the modified GAD Code of Dumalinao, to prevent the occurrence of gender-based sexual harassment in streets and public spaces, online, in workplaces and in educational and training institutions in the Municipality of Dumalinao, Zamboanga del Sur, and appropriating funds for the purpose thereof and discussed the important features and purposes in ensuring women's right and protection and their full participation in the community.
- 3. Hon. Ma. Gemma C. Albiso presented the proposed ordinance amending the Children's Code of the Municipality of Dumalinao, Zamboanga del Sur, and explained important matters to ensure the protection of children against all forms of abuse, exploitation and discrimination.
- 4. Hon. Ma. Gemma C. Albiso presented the proposed ordinance prioritizing the Pantawid Pamilyang Pilipino Program (4Ps) beneficiaries including the existing households for convergence provision pursuant to RA 11310, and appropriating funds and for other purposes and deliberated the social assistance program, which is to provide support to the poor family to alleviate their needs and enables the children to be able to obtain their academic needs such as educational materials and supplies.
- 5. Hon. Hermes B. Cabales presented the proposed ordinance amending certain sections and imposition of new fees and charges of Municipal Ordinance No. 2014-08-384 as amended by Municipal Ordinance No. 2020-03-441 otherwise known as the Revenue Code of the Municipality of Dumalinao, Zamboanga del Sur.
- 6. Hon. Jelito R. Peñonal presented the proposed ordinance mandating the enforcement of pre-emptive and forced evacuation during emergency situations caused by man-made or natural disaster and providing additional guidelines thereof, amending for the purpose ordinance no. 2017-05-419 of the Municipality of Dumalinao, Zamboanga del Sur.
- 7. Hon. Romeo D. Parila presented the proposed ordinance, prescribing proper management, containment and control of African Swine Fever (ASF) in the Municipality of Dumalinao, Zamboanga del Sur, imposing penalties for violations and appropriating funds thereof and explained the purpose and importance of the guidelines and implementation of African Swine Fever (ASF) in the locality, which is to avoid highly contagious viral disease of swine.



- 8. Hon. Romeo D. Parila presented the proposed ordinance preserving and promoting the indigenous culture and arts in the Municipality of Dumalinao, Zamboanga del Sur, providing funds thereof.
- 9. Hon. Jelito R. Peñonal presented the proposed ordinance requiring all businesses, commercial complexes, and establishments considered as high risk to install Close Circuit Television (CCTV) camera and providing penalties for violation thereof. According to Hon. Jelito R. Peñonal the purpose of this ordinance is to help and prevent the occurrence of the crime rate in the locality and to ensure the public with regards to the safety of the community.
- 10. Hon. Romeo G. Ligan presented the proposed ordinance declaring and establishing the Four Hundred Thirty-Nine Thousand Six Hundred (439,600) square meters coastal area of Zone 1 as Mangrove Protected Area, providing funds and penalties for the purpose thereof.

C. OPEN FORUM.

Mrs. Jenelyn Daal from Purok 1 questioned in 2 years wala ko kadawat sa 4P's, ang akung pangutana asa napaingun ang funding nga dapat akung makuha. Hon. Ma. Gemma C. Albiso replied nga e-refer sa local 4P's office for clarification and guidance.

Hon. Romeo P. Aranas, Barangay Kagawad of Rebokon raised a question Pananglitan ang mga tawo sa evacuation center, ang baroy ug madasigun nga naa sa upper portion, pwede bana nato sila ma mapugos nga apil gihapon sila if ever nga mo evacuate.

Pugson, jud na sila kay wa ta kabalo ang kana nga upper portion maapektaran sa tsunami, Hon. Jelito R. Peñonal replied.

Hon. Romeo P. Aranas suggested if ever nga dile jud nato sila mapugos, pwede ba nga akung isugyot nga under-monitoring sila for safety.

Hon. Jelito R. Peñonal said yes sir pwede ra.

Hon. Jonmar Rapel, Barangay Kagawad of Rebokon asked with regards sa area covered sa 4.36 hectares nga Mangrove Protected Area, asa dapit ang area covered sa Pantad to Baroy? Beside sa fishpond, covered batong area-ha sa 4.26 hectares? Kay naa rabay uban nga ilang balikon og open katong mga abandoned fishpond, kana nga mga fishpond covered bana sa LGU.



Hon. Romeo G. Ligan answered koralon ang area nga sakop sa 4.36 hectares, then basta abandoned fishpond, mo inspection pa ang DENR kabahin ana ug naa pai again nga mga legal nga process.

Hon. Jonmar Rapel questioned if kanang mga fishpond nga naa sa front area, apil ba gihapon nasa protected area? Then kanang mga protected area pwede bana nato botngan og fishpond.

Hon. Romeo G. Ligan answered nga eagi pa sa process sa pagdeclare nga abandon nga ang maong fishpond.

D. CLOSING REMARKS.

A closing remarks was given to Hon. Jonmar Rapel the Barangay Kagawad of Rebokon, Dumalinao, Zamboanga del Sur.

A RESOLUTION ADOPTING AND APPROVING THE FINDINGS AND RECOMMENDATION OF THE COMMITTEE ON FAMILY, WOMEN AND CHILDREN IN ITS COMMITTEE REPORT NO. 984-2024 DATED 18 APRIL 2024, THEREBY, DECLARING VALID MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE NO. 2024-02-500 DATED 19 FEBRUARY 2024 OF DUMALINAO, ZAMBOANGA DEL SUR

WHEREAS, presented for consideration and appropriate action is Committee Report No. 984-2024 dated 18 April 2024 of the Committee on Family, Women and Children which recommended that Municipal Ordinance No. 2024-02-500 dated 19 February 2024 of Dumalinao, Zamboanga del Sur entitled "AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING ADDITIONAL GUIDELINES FOR SAFE SPACES ACT IN THE MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE NO. 2017-05-413, OTHERWISE KNOWN AS THE MODIFIED GAD CODE OF DUMALINAO, TO PREVENT THE OCCURRENCE OF GENDER-BASED SEXUAL HARASSMENT IN STREETS AND PUBLIC PLACES, ONLINE, IN WORKPLACES, AND EDUCATIONAL AND TRAINING INSTITUTIONS ΙN THEMUNICIPALITY DUMALINAO, ZAMBOANGAL DEL SUR, AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS FOR THE PURPOSE THEREOF" be declared valid;

WHEREAS, after a careful and exhaustive review of the subject Municipal Ordinance of Dumalinao, the Committee concerned has, as hereinafter copied in toto, the following pertinent findings and remarks, to wit:

"The Committee finds Municipal Ordinance No. 2024-02-500 of Dumalinao, Zamboanga del Sur to be in order and in conformity with the existing national laws and appearing to be an enabling ordinance specifically to R.A. No. 11313, better known as Safe Spaces Act, an act defining gender-based sexual harassment that recognizes both men and women must have equality, security and safety not only in private but also in streets, in public spaces, online, in workplaces,

and educational and training institutions, and this Ordinance is enacted purposely to incorporate in the Municipal GAD Code of the Locality and implement the primary responsibilities of the LGU Dumalinao in enforcing the pertinent provisions of Republic Act No. 11313 to provide measure and prevent the occurrence of genderbased sexual harassment in the locality.

Further emphasized under Section 8(a) of R.A. 11313 that LGUs shall bear primary responsibility in enforcing the provisions of the Safe Spaces Act and shall likewise pass an ordinance which shall localize the applicability thereof which even our Province of Zamboanga del Sur has consistently adhered by passing and approving SP Provincial Ordinance No. 020-2023, otherwise known as the Zamboanga del Sur Safe Spaces Act Ordinance."

WHEREAS, after a careful perusal, it is found that Committee Report No. 984-2024 of said Committee is proper and in order, thus, this 11th Sangguniang Panlalawigan adopts the findings and recommendation contained therein:
