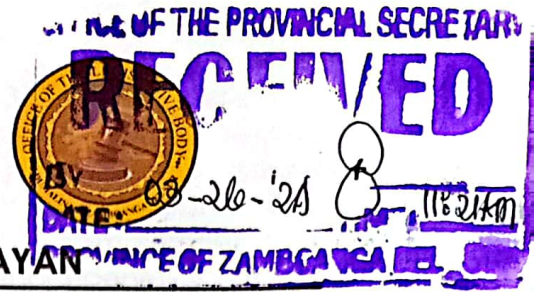

MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE NO. 2024-02-502

AN ORDINANCE PRIORITIZING THE PANTAWID PAMILYANG PILIPINO PROGRAM (4PS) BENEFICIARIES, INCLUDING THE EXITING HOUSEHOLDS FOR CONVERGENCE PROVISION UNDER REPUBLIC ACT NO. 11310 AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the Local Government Unit of Dumalinao recognizes the Pantawid Pamilyang Pilipino Program (4Ps) as one of the Philippine's poverty reduction strategies;

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 19 of Republic Act 11310, Convergence of Programs and Services states that within the framework of a national poverty alleviation strategy and a holistic social protection program, the various agencies of government implementing multi-stakeholder programs and services for the poor shall guarantee that the same complement and converge seamlessly to ensure that the targeted household-beneficiaries are alleviated from poverty and remain non-poor even after the prescribed maximum period for the conditional cash grant. Such convergence shall focus on the enhancement of operational efficiency and the strengthening of inter-agency partnerships. The government shall monitor the performance of these agencies to ensure the sustainability and positive impact of its pro-poor programs;

WHEREAS, Republic Act 7160, or the Local Government Code of 1991, consistent with local autonomy and decentralization, the provision for the delivery of basic services and facilities shall be devolved from the National Government to provinces, cities, municipalities, and barangays so that each LGU shall be responsible for a minimum set of services and facilities following established national policies, guidelines, and standards;


WHEREAS, as provided for in Article XIII of the 1987 Constitution, the Congress shall give the highest priority to the enactment of measures that protect and enhance the right of all the people to human dignity, reduce social, economic, and political inequalities, and remove cultural inequities by equitably diffusing wealth and political power for the common good;

WHEREAS, the promotion of social justice shall include the commitment to create economic opportunities based on freedom of initiative and self-reliance. Towards this end, the State shall establish programs that invest and harness our country's human capital and improve the delivery of basic services to the poor, particularly education, health, and nutrition, which is an intervention anticipated to break the intergenerational cycle of poverty;

WHEREAS, to break the intergenerational cycle of poverty through investment in human capital and improved delivery of basic services to the poor, particularly education, health, nutrition, and early childhood care and development. Promote gender equality and empowerment of women and children's rights; Achieve universal primary education; Reduce child mortality and malnutrition; Improve maternal health; Ensure healthy lives and promote well-being for all;

WHEREAS, the Department of Interior and Local Government (DILG) and the Department of Social Welfare and Development (DSWD) recently signed Joint Memorandum Circular (JMC) No. 2022-001 providing the guidelines in support of 4Ps, following the implementation of full devolution to LGUs under Executive Order (EO) No. 138 series of 2021 signed by President Duterte;

WHEREAS, in view of the preceding, the LGU-Dumalinao deems it necessary to support our constituents to alleviate their life situation and be free from poverty by aiding the 4Ps beneficiaries, including the exited 4Ps beneficiaries with the convergence of services and linking them to partner agencies for the enjoyment of their programs and services;

NOW, THEREFORE, on motion by **HON. HERMES B. CABALES** and severally seconded by the august body;

BE IT ORDAINED by the 12th Sangguniang Bayan of Dumalinao, Zamboanga del Sur, in session assembled that:

SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE. This Ordinance shall be known as the *"Prioritizing the 4Ps beneficiaries, including the exiting households for the Convergence Program in the Municipality of Dumalinao, Zamboanga del Sur"*.

SECTION 2. DEFINITION OF TERMS. As used in this Ordinance, the following terms and phrases shall mean:

a. Convergence of Services - refers to provision of various services needed by the Pantawid Pamilyang Pilipino Program (4Ps) Households from different agencies, civil organizations, non-governmental organizations, self-help groups and other partners.

b. Exited Household Beneficiaries - refers to the Pantawid Pamilyang Pilipino Program (4Ps) Households who are officially disengaged from the program due to natural attrition or not eligible to continue their exposure to the program and who remains in their survival or subsistence level of household well-being. The Department of Social Welfare and Development holds the sole authority to officially deem a beneficiary disengaged from the Program.

c. Graduated Household Beneficiaries - refers to the improvement of the level of well-being of poor households from survival and subsistence to self-sufficiency towards their eventual exit from the program through provision of integrated and holistic support services and programs.

d. Household Well-Being - refers to status of the family as to their economic sufficiency and social adequacy whether they are in a survival, subsistence, or self-sufficiency level. It is assessed using Social Welfare and Development Indicators through a score matrix which gets the average of the actual scores of the indicators. The said assessment is conducted by the Municipal Link or the Case Manager assigned in the area.

e. Qualified Household-Beneficiaries - refers to households identified by the DSWD for entitlement to the monthly conditional cash grants.

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f. Responsible Person/s - refers to the parent or guardian in the qualified Pantawid Pamilyang Pilipino Program (4Ps) Household Beneficiary.

g. Habitual Alcoholism/Drunkenness - refers to excessive and/or regular consumption of intoxicating beverages despite adverse consequences on the individual's physical, mental, social, and occupational functioning.

SECTION 3. EMPLOYMENT, LIVELIHOOD, AND OTHER BASIC SOCIAL SERVICE INTERVENTIONS. The 4Ps Household Beneficiaries, including the 4Ps exited members shall be given priority in the availment of the services and interventions or other appropriate or similar programs offered by the Local Government Unit of Dumalinao and other government agencies or accredited private institutions. Furthermore, they shall also be given priority in the availment of the employment facilitation services provided by the Public Employment Service Office (PESO) of the municipality or other employment programs of appropriate government agencies implementing the same.

SECTION 4. ADMINISTRATIVE AND LOGISTIC SUPPORT. The Local Government Unit of Dumalinao through the Office of the Municipal Social Welfare and Development Office (MSWDO) shall provide office space and other support to the Pantawid Pamilya Municipal Operation Office which includes but not limited to office supplies, equipment, and other paraphernalia for the program implementation.

SECTION 5. CONVERGENCE FOCAL AND OTHER STAFF. The LGU-Dumalinao shall designate a Convergence Focal Person and one (1) Data Entry/Computer Operator who will focus, assist, and facilitate referral and information as well as the provision of services or post-services needed by the Pantawid Pamilyang Pilipino Program (4Ps) Household Beneficiaries, including the exited beneficiaries.

SECTION 6. FUNDING. The Municipal Mayor shall appropriate funds to be used to implement the Convergence Strategy. The funds shall be taken from the Office of the Municipal Mayor, the amount of which shall be determined in coordination with DSWD and MSWDO through work and financial planning and shall be included in the Annual Investment Plan (AIP).

SECTION 7. PROHIBITED ACTS. The following are the prohibited acts of the Responsible Person/s with continuing Qualified Household-Beneficiaries from the Household who has an Exited Beneficiary, enumerated as follows:

a. Failure, without justifiable cause, of responsible person/s to send his/her/their children or grandchildren to school from kindergarten 1 to Grade 12;

b. Responsible person/s who are engaged in the following vices: 1. Illegal Gambling; and/or 2. Habitual Alcoholism/Drunkenness.

SECTION 8. NO IMPOSITION OF PENALTY AGAINST THE CHILDREN. No penalty shall be imposed on children for the violation of this Ordinance. Instead, they shall be referred to the Municipal Social Welfare and Development Office (MSWDO) of Dumalinao.

The child and the responsible person thereto shall undergo appropriate interventions with a holistic approach such as counseling, information, and referral to partner agencies to ensure that the responsible person commits to sending their children to school while the child concerned will also commit to studying in kindergarten or elementary or secondary school.

SECTION 9. PENALTIES. Responsible person/s who violate this Ordinance shall be penalized as follows:

a. First Offense - stern warning and mandatory counselling (2-4 counselling sessions);

b. Second Offense - stern warning and mandatory counselling, (2-4 counselling sessions); and

c. Third Offense - stern warning, mandatory counselling (2-4 counselling sessions), and be removed from the priority list for the services and program provided by this Ordinance.

SECTION 10. INTERPRETATION. Except otherwise provided by this Ordinance and its Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR), any ambiguity as to the interpretation of the power granted to the concerned offices and personnel under the Local Government Unit of Dumalinao shall be resolved and interpreted in favor of the 4Ps Program and of its beneficiaries including the exiting households.

SECTION 11. MUNICIPAL ACTION TEAM. The Municipal Action Team (MAT) shall be the highest convergence policy making body in the municipal level and shall convene at least three (3) times a year or whenever it deems necessary.

The MAT shall be chaired by the Municipal Mayor and co-chaired by the Municipal Social Welfare and Development Officer (MSWDO). The MAT shall be composed of the following members:

a. Office of the Municipal Planning and Development Coordinator;

b. Office of the Municipal Budget Officer;

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- c. Office of the Municipal Treasurer;
- d. Office of the Municipal Health;
- e. Office of the Municipal Social Welfare Development;
- f. Public Employment Service Office (PESO);
- g. Office of the Municipal Agriculture;
- h. Office of the Municipal Environment and Natural Resources;
- i. Office of the Local Disaster Risk Reduction and Management;
- j. SB Member/Chairperson of Committee on Public Works and Highways;
- k. SB Member/Chairperson of Committee on Family and Children;
- l. 4Ps Parent Leaders' Federation Representative/s; and
- m. Other People's organizations, Private entities, Business sectors, and NGOs.

SECTION 12. DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES OF MAT MEMBERS. The following are the duties and responsibilities of the responsible person/s concerned and the government agencies thereto:

a. The Municipal Mayor's Office shall be the lead office in developing, establishing, and implementing convergence strategies and initiatives and to harness inputs and productivity from among the members of the MAT.

b. Municipal Social Welfare and Development Office shall be the Co-chairman of MAT.

c. Other members of the MAT shall ensure provision of collaborative effort to the operationalization of the partnership/convergence strategy at the municipal level guided by the scorecard based on SWDI. The scorecard shall assess the overall level well-being of the HH beneficiaries in the municipality as bases for the formulation of policy advocacy agenda being presented to the Local Chief Executives for support and sustainability of projects initiated by the 4Ps HH beneficiaries;

The MAT members shall guarantee support on the seamless complementation of programs, services, and interventions that will support the ultimate attainment of the Program's long-term plan an improved level of well-being of

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4Ps HHs towards self-sufficiency and resiliency as they exit from the Program and others that may be assigned to them or agreed upon by the body.

SECTION 13. GRADUATED HOUSEHOLD BENEFICIARIES. The Graduated Household Beneficiaries shall be exempted from the implementation of this Ordinance.


SECTION 14. IMPLEMENTING RULES AND REGULATIONS (IRR). Within sixty (60) days upon the approval of this Ordinance, the Municipal Mayor shall, in coordination with the appropriate government offices and agencies, promulgate the necessary rules and regulations to carry out the provisions of this Ordinance.

SECTION 15. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE. Should any provision of this Ordinance be found unconstitutional by the court of law, such provision shall be severed from the remainder of this Ordinance, and such action shall not affect the enforceability of the remaining provisions of this Ordinance.

SECTION 16. EFFECTIVITY CLAUSE. This Ordinance shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its posting in three (3) conspicuous places within the municipality.



PUBLIC HEARING MINUTES AND ATTENDANCE

EXCERPTS FROM THE MINUTES OF THE PUBLIC HEARING OF THE PROPOSED ORDINANCES OF THE 12TH SANGGUNIANG BAYAN OF DUMALINAO, ZAMBOANGA DEL SUR ON JANUARY 19, 2024, HELD AT MUNICIPAL GYMNASIUM, DUMALINAO ZAMBOANGA DEL SUR.

A. OPENING SESSION.

The meeting commenced with an opening prayer was given by Hon. Vicente F. Munion and followed by the singing of the Philippine national anthem led by Hon. Aileen P. Lira.

The Municipal Vice Mayor Hon. Wilfredo L. Malong Sr., given an welcome remarks.

- Overview of the conduct of Public Hearing.

- Hon. Hermes Cabaes the chairman on Committee on Rules and Good Government and Public Accountability gives an overview of the conduct of the public hearing.

B. PRESENTATION OF PROPOSED ORDINANCES.

1. Hon. Frederick R. Balandra presented the proposed ordinance enacting the Municipal Code pursuing a Public- Private Partnership for the people initiative for Local Government Unit (LGU P4) approach towards developments, providing for the procedure for the selecting the private sector proponent adopting a contract management framework and providing appropriation and for other purposes and discussed the important features and purpose of the ordinance that seeks to foster collaboration between the public and private sectors to drive sustainable development and address community needs.

2. Hon. Ma. Gemma C. Albiso presented the proposed ordinance providing an additional guidelines of Safe Spaces Act in the Municipal Ordinance No. 2017-05-413, otherwise known as the modified GAD Code of Dumalinao, to prevent

the occurrence of gender-based sexual harassment in streets and public spaces, online, in workplaces and in educational and training institutions in the Municipality of Dumalinao, Zamboanga del Sur, and appropriating funds for the purpose thereof and discussed the important features and purposes in ensuring women's right and protection and their full participation in the community.

3. Hon. Ma. Gemma C. Albiso presented the proposed ordinance amending the Children's Code of the Municipality of Dumalinao, Zamboanga del Sur, and explained important matters to ensure the protection of children against all forms of abuse, exploitation and discrimination.

4. Hon. Ma. Gemma C. Albiso presented the proposed ordinance prioritizing the Pantawid Pamilyang Pilipino Program (4Ps) beneficiaries including the existing households for convergence provision pursuant to RA 11310, and appropriating funds and for other purposes and deliberated the social assistance program, which is to provide support to the poor family to alleviate their needs and enables the children to be able to obtain their academic needs such as educational materials and supplies.

5. Hon. Hermes B. Cabaless presented the proposed ordinance amending certain sections and imposition of new fees and charges of Municipal Ordinance No. 2014-08-384 as amended by Municipal Ordinance No. 2020-03-441 otherwise known as the Revenue Code of the Municipality of Dumalinao, Zamboanga del Sur.

6. Hon. Jelito R. Peñonal presented the proposed ordinance mandating the enforcement of pre-emptive and forced evacuation during emergency situations caused by man-made or natural disaster and providing additional guidelines thereof, amending for the purpose ordinance no. 2017-05-419 of the Municipality of Dumalinao, Zamboanga del Sur.

7. Hon. Romeo D. Parila presented the proposed ordinance, prescribing proper management, containment and control of African Swine Fever (ASF) in the Municipality of Dumalinao, Zamboanga del Sur, imposing penalties for violations and appropriating funds thereof and explained the purpose and importance of the guidelines and implementation of African Swine Fever (ASF) in the locality, which is to avoid highly contagious viral disease of domestic and wild pigs.

8. Hon. Romeo D. Parila presented the proposed ordinance preserving and promoting the indigenous culture and arts in the Municipality of Dumalinao, Zamboanga del Sur, providing funds thereof.

9. Hon. Jelito R. Peñonal presented the proposed ordinance requiring all businesses, commercial complexes, and establishments considered as high risk

to install Close Circuit Television (CCTV) camera and providing penalties for violation thereof. According to Hon. Jelito R. Peñonal the purpose of this ordinance is to help and prevent the occurrence of the crime rate in the locality and to ensure the public with regards to the safety of the community.

10. Hon. Romeo G. Ligan presented the proposed ordinance declaring and establishing the Four Hundred Thirty-Nine Thousand Six Hundred (439,600) square meters coastal area of Zone 1 as Mangrove Protected Area, providing funds and penalties for the purpose thereof.

C. OPEN FORUM.

Mr. Clemente Ema from DOREMIA Organization, raised a question if unsa jud ta ka sure nga kanang tubiga safe na siya imnon.

Engr. Archuny Ozaraga, the resource speaker answered nga moagi na ang atong tubig sa examine para atong makita nga safe bana nga imnon or naa pa ba siya'y hugaw.

Mr. Clemente Ema asked puro rajud ba penalty ang nakaprovide sa proposed ordinance establishing Magrove Protected Area? Wala bana'y Exemption.

Hon. Romeo G. Ligan answered nga naa tay exemption sama sa educational tour, authorized ka nga mosulod sa maong lugar and justifiable emung reason nganung naabot emung mga hayop dra sa area.



EXCERPTS FROM THE MINUTES OF THE PUBLIC HEARING OF THE PROPOSED ORDINANCES OF THE 12TH SANGGUNIANG BAYAN OF DUMALINAO, ZAMBOANGA DEL SUR ON JANUARY 24, 2024, HELD AT BARANGAY REBOKON, COVERED COURT, MUNICIPALITY OF DUMALINAO, ZAMBOANGA DEL SUR.

A. OPENING SESSION.

The meeting commenced with an opening prayer and followed by the singing of the Philippines national anthem through audio-visual presentation.

The opening remarks was given by Hon. Joel L. Famor, ABC President/Punong Barangay of Rebokon and followed by a short message given by the Municipal Vice Mayor Hon. Wilfredo L. Malong Sr.

- Acknowledgement of the participants and speakers.

- Mr. Darrylle Angelou Dalid the acting Secretary to the Sanggunian, acknowledged the participants and the key speakers of the said activity.

- Overview of the conduct of Public Hearing.

- Hon. Hermes Cabales the chairman on Committee on Rules and Good Government and Public Accountability, gives an overview of the importance in conducting a public hearing of the proposed ordinance by the legislative council.

B. PRESENTATION OF PROPOSED ORDINANCES.

1. Hon. Frederick R. Balandra presented the proposed ordinance enacting the Municipal Code pursuing a Public- Private Partnership for the people initiative for Local Government Unit (LGU P4) approach towards developments, providing for the procedure for the selecting the private sector proponent adopting a contract management framework and providing appropriation and for other purposes and discussed the important features and purpose of the ordinance that seeks to foster collaboration between the public and private sectors to drive sustainable development and address community needs.

2. Hon. Ma. Gemma C. Albiso presented the proposed ordinance providing an additional guidelines of Safe Spaces Act in the Municipal Ordinance No. 2017-05-413, otherwise known as the modified GAD Code of Dumalinao, to prevent the occurrence of gender-based sexual harassment in streets and public spaces, online, in workplaces and in educational and training institutions in the Municipality of Dumalinao, Zamboanga del Sur, and appropriating funds for the purpose thereof and discussed the important features and purposes in ensuring women's right and protection and their full participation in the community.

3. Hon. Ma. Gemma C. Albiso presented the proposed ordinance amending the Children's Code of the Municipality of Dumalinao, Zamboanga del Sur, and explained important matters to ensure the protection of children against all forms of abuse, exploitation and discrimination.

4. Hon. Ma. Gemma C. Albiso presented the proposed ordinance prioritizing the Pantawid Familyang Pilipino Program (4Ps) beneficiaries including the existing households for convergence provision pursuant to RA 11310, and appropriating funds and for other purposes and deliberated the social assistance program, which is to provide support to the poor family to alleviate their needs and enables the children to be able to obtain their academic needs such as educational materials and supplies.

5. Hon. Hermes B. Cabales presented the proposed ordinance amending certain sections and imposition of new fees and charges of Municipal Ordinance No. 2014-08-384 as amended by Municipal Ordinance No. 2020-03-441 otherwise known as the Revenue Code of the Municipality of Dumalinao, Zamboanga del Sur.

6. Hon. Jelito R. Peñonal presented the proposed ordinance mandating the enforcement of pre-emptive and forced evacuation during emergency situations caused by man-made or natural disaster and providing additional guidelines thereof, amending for the purpose ordinance no. 2017-05-419 of the Municipality of Dumalinao, Zamboanga del Sur.

7. Hon. Romeo D. Parila presented the proposed ordinance, prescribing proper management, containment and control of African Swine Fever (ASF) in the Municipality of Dumalinao, Zamboanga del Sur, imposing penalties for violations and appropriating funds thereof and explained the purpose and importance of the guidelines and implementation of African Swine Fever (ASF) in the locality, which is to avoid highly contagious viral disease of swine.

8. Hon. Romeo D. Parila presented the proposed ordinance preserving and promoting the indigenous culture and arts in the Municipality of Dumalinao, Zamboanga del Sur, providing funds thereof.

9. Hon. Jelito R. Peñonal presented the proposed ordinance requiring all businesses, commercial complexes, and establishments considered as high risk to install Close Circuit Television (CCTV) camera and providing penalties for violation thereof. According to Hon. Jelito R. Peñonal the purpose of this ordinance is to help and prevent the occurrence of the crime rate in the locality and to ensure the public with regards to the safety of the community.

10. Hon. Romeo G. Ligan presented the proposed ordinance declaring and establishing the Four Hundred Thirty-Nine Thousand Six Hundred (439,600) square meters coastal area of Zone 1 as Mangrove Protected Area, providing funds and penalties for the purpose thereof.

C. OPEN FORUM.

Mrs. Jenelyn Daal from Purok 1 questioned in 2 years wala ko kadawat sa 4P's, ang akung pangutana asa napaingun ang funding nga dapat akung makuha. Hon. Ma. Gemma C. Albiso replied nga e-refer sa local 4P's office for clarification and guidance.

Hon. Romeo P. Aranas, Barangay Kagawad of Rebokon raised a question Pananglitan ang mga tawo sa evacuation center, ang baroy ug madasigun nga naa sa upper portion, pwede bana nato sila ma mapugos nga apil gihapon sila if ever nga mo evacuate.

Pugson, jud na sila kay wa ta kabalo ang kana nga upper portion maapektaran sa tsunami, Hon. Jelito R. Peñonal replied.

Hon. Romeo P. Aranas suggested if ever nga dile jud nato sila mapugos, pwede ba nga akung isugyot nga under-monitoring sila for safety.

Hon. Jelito R. Peñonal said yes sir pwede ra.

Hon. Jonmar Rapel, Barangay Kagawad of Rebokon asked with regards sa area covered sa 4.36 hectares nga Mangrove Protected Area, asa dapit ang area covered sa Pantad to Baroy? Beside sa fishpond, covered batong area-ha sa 4.26 hectares? Kay naa rabay uban nga ilang balikon og open katong mga abandoned fishpond, kana nga mga fishpond covered bana sa LGU.

Hon. Romeo G. Ligan answered koralon ang area nga sakop sa 4.36 hectares, then basta abandoned fishpond, mo inspection pa ang DENR kabahin ana ug naa pai again nga mga legal nga process.

Hon. Jonmar Rapel questioned if kanang mga fishpond nga naa sa front area, apil ba gihapon nasa protected area? Then kanang mga protected area pwede bana nato botngan og fishpond.

Hon. Romeo G. Ligan answered nga eagi pa sa process sa pagdeclare nga abandon nga ang maong fishpond.


