
AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE OPERATIONS OF COMMERCIAL AND BACKYARD PIGGERY, POULTRY, AND OTHER LIVESTOCK IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF DUMALINAO, ZAMBOANGA DEL SUR, PROVIDING PENALTIES AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

**WHEREAS**, presented for consideration and appropriate action is the proposed ordinance regulating the operations of commercial and backyard piggery, poultry, and other livestock in the Municipality of Dumalinao, Zamboanga del Sur, providing penalties and for other purposes;



**WHEREAS**, after careful review and exhaustive deliberation, and after finding the same to be proper and order;

**NOW THEREFORE,** on motion by **HON. ROMEO G. LIGAN** and severally seconded by the August body;

**BE IT ORDAINED** by the 12<sup>th</sup> Sangguniang Bayan of Dumalinao in session duly assembled that:

#### ARTICLE I. TITLE, LEGAL BASIS, AND OBJECTIVES.

**SECTION I. TITLE.** This ordinance shall be known as "Piggery and Poultry Raising Regulation Ordinance".

**SECTION II. LEGAL BASIS.** This ordinance is in accordance with the provisions of Presidential Decree 856, otherwise known as the Sanitation Code of the Philippines, Republic Act No. 9003, otherwise known as the Ecological Solid Waste Management Act, Republic Act No. 8749, otherwise known as the Clean Air Act, Republic Act No. 9275 otherwise known as the Clean Water Act, and Republic Act No. 7160 otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991 and their Implementing Rules and Regulations.

**SECTION III.** This ordinance shall have the following objectives:


- a. To ensure that all piggery (commercial or backyard), poultry, and other livestock-raising businesses and activities in the Municipality of Dumalinao are compliant with the existing pertinent laws, rules, and regulations;
- b. To protect public health and safety and promote the general welfare with a particular focus on minimizing, if not eliminating, obnoxious odor, fly and mosquito infestation, and water pollution;
- c. To assist in the growth of piggery, poultry, and livestock businesses and activities in the Municipality of Dumalinao through regulated management and administration; and
- d. To serve as the legal or policy framework for managing piggery and poultry farms (commercial and backyard).

ARTICLE II. SCOPE, COVERAGE, APPLICATION AND DEFINITION OF TERMS.

**SECTION IV. SCOPE AND COVERAGE.** This ordinance shall cover to all piggery, poultry, and livestock farming whether for backyard or for commercial purposes, operating or to be established within the territorial jurisdiction of the Municipality of Dumalinao, Zamboanga del Sur.

**SECTION V. DEFINITION OF TERMS.** As used in this ordinance, the following terms shall mean:

- a. Commercial Piggery shall refer to raising or breeding, depasturing, feeding, or watering of pigs or swine used for commercial purposes. It shall be classified into:
  - 1. Small one (1) head for farrowing and six (6) nine (9) fattening;
- 2. Medium two (2) heads for farrowing and ten (10) twenty (20) fattening; and
- 3. Large two (2) heads for farrowing and more than twenty (20) fattening.
- b. Backyard hog raising shall refer to the raising of swine in a household backyard for the purpose of household consumption. It involves five (5) heads for fattening and one (1) head for farrowing.
- c. Poultry a collective term for all domesticated fowl as chicken, turkey, ducks, or geese, except commercial game fowl or breeds used for cock fighting.
- d. Commercial Poultry shall refer to the raising of domesticated fowls, which serve as sources of eggs and meat for human consumption. It involves less than or below one hundred (100) heads of domesticated fowl.
- e. Municipal Permit a document issued by the municipal mayor or after complying with the requirements and regulatory fees before a commercial piggery and commercial poultry operates.
- f. Locational Clearance a document issued by the Municipal Planning and Development Coordinator that the proposed commercial piggery and commercial poultry complies with the Comprehensive Land Use Plan (CLUP) of the municipality.
  - g. Farrowing refers to a swine for giving birth.
  - h. Fattening refers to a swine primary for slaughter.
- i. Barangay Clearance is a permit given by the barangay where the piggery, poultry, and livestock establishment will be located.
- j. Built-Up Areas is an area that is full of houses, shops, offices and other buildings with very little open space;



- k. Environmental Compliance Certificate a document issued by the Municipal Environment and Natural Resources Office (MENRO) certifying that based on the representation of the project proponent as reviewed and validated by the appropriate agency, the proposed project or undertaking will not cause a significant adverse environmental impact and the proponent has complied with all the requirements.
- I. Individual refers to persons/employees working in the piggery, poultry, and livestock establishments.
- m. Livestock includes, but is not limited to, cattle, sheep, goats, swine, and equine animals.
  - n. Porous Soil soil where water easily passes through.
- o. Proper Waste Disposal Management is an integrated system, approach, or process on the generation, segregation, storage, collection, transport, processing, recycling, recovery, and final disposal or containment of waste material.
  - p. Highland is an elevated land area on natural ground or man-made.
- q. Sanitary Permit is a certificate given to business applicants who were able to comply with the standards of the Sanitation Code of the Philippines.
- r. Septic Tank is a sewage-disposal tank in which anaerobic bacteria decompose a continuous flow of waste material.
- s. Vermin is a group of insects or small animals such as flies, mosquitoes, cockroaches, lies, bedbugs, mice and rats that are vectors of diseases.

## ARTICLE III. REGULATORY REQUIREMENTS FOR COMMERCIAL PIGGERY AND POULTRY.

- **SECTION VI. DOCUMENTARY REQUIREMENTS.** All commercial piggery and commercial poultry shall secure the following permits and documentary clearance, to wit:
  - a. Barangay Clearance;
- b. Municipal Clearance: 1. Locational Clearance; 2. MENRO Certification; 3. Health Certification/Sanitary Certificate; and 4. Business Permit; and
  - c. Department of Environment and Natural Resources, ECC Certification.

All plans, designs, specifications, and special features of the proposed commercial piggery and poultry farm structure must be submitted to the Office of Municipal Agriculture for review and approval prior to the issuance of a permit.

**SECTION VII. DOCUMENTARY FEES.** The fees payable on applications and/or renewals for municipal permits and registration for commercial piggery and poultry, including the requirements and certification thereof, shall be in accordance with the existing Municipal Revenue Code and other ordinances, rules, and regulations.

## ARTICLE III. REGULATORY REQUIREMENTS FOR BACKYARD PIGGERY AND POULTRY.

**SECTION VIII. DOCUMENTARY REQUIREMENTS.** All backyard piggery and barkyard poultry shall secure the following permits and documentary clearance, to wit:

- a. Purok Clearance:
- b. Barangay Clearance;
- c. MENRO Certification; and
- d. Health Certification/Sanitary Certification.

#### ARTICLE IV. ZONING AND STRUCTURAL REQUIREMENTS.

**SECTION IX. LOCATIONAL REQUIREMENTS.** Piggery, poultry, and other livestock shall conform to the following locational requirements:

- a. The farm should preferably be situated in a high topography and broad terrain for good ventilation. For proper drainage, it should be located in rolling terrain.
- b. Flood-prone areas and other environmentally critical areas like water supply sources shall be avoided.
- c. Shall not be built on soils with high moisture levels. The soil must be well-drained and porous;
- d. Commercial piggery and poultry farms shall be surrounded by a buffer zone to be planted with trees or shrubs;
- e. Piggery and poultry farms shall not be located within a 25 meters radius of the source of ground and surface drinking water;

- f. Commercial piggery and poultry farms shall be at least 1,000 meters away from the built-up areas (residential, commercial, institutional, and industrial) as designated in the Municipality's Comprehensive Land Use Plan (CLUP), while backyard poultry and piggery farms shall be at allowed in their respective backyard, provided that the owner shall have a sewage-disposal tank and proper waste disposal management.
- g. The establishment of commercial farming shall be located in accordance with the municipality's zoning classification.
- h. Commercial piggery farms shall be 500 meters away from the national highway and major roads, while commercial poultry farms shall be 200 meters away from the national highway and major roads.
- i. Commercial piggery and poultry farms shall be at least one (1) kilometer apart to minimize the spread of pests and reduce the concentration of air pollutants in a given area. The gap distance for backyard poultry and piggery farms shall be 500 meters.
- j. The position of farm buildings that house the animals shall be oriented towards the direction of the wind and/or sunlight and in an east-west direction.
- k. The long axis of the building with a double pen shall be laid in a north-south direction to give all pens sunlight.
- I. Piggery farms are strictly required to construct biogas digester or standard septic tank for animal waste disposal and conform with the following requirements:
  - 1. It shall watertight;
- 2. It shall be built on concrete and size proportional to the stock population;
- 3. It shall not be constructed under any building within twenty-five (25) meters radius from the nearest ground water.
- m. Commercial piggery and poultry farms are encouraged to maintain a generator set sufficient to supply power to the farm buildings in case of power failure, avoiding problems with the water supply, ventilation and cooling, heating, and moisturizing needs of the animals and their wastes.

**SECTION X. RELOCATION OF COMMERCIAL PIGGERY, POULTRY, AND LIVESTOCK FARM.** Existing piggery, poultry, and other livestock in commercial quantities within the residential/build-up areas shall be given one (1) year upon the effectivity of this Ordinance to close or relocate to an area deemed to be suitable for the purpose as delimited under the preceding section.

**SECTION XI. RELOCATION OF BACKYARD PIGGERY, POULTRY, AND LIVESTOCK FARM.** The operation of backyard piggery, poultry, and other livestock that do not conform to the preceding section shall close or relocate their backyard piggery, poultry, and livestock farm to alight residential and farm areas and shall strictly follow the provided structural requirements and proper waste management disposal.

**SECTION XII. PROPER WASTE DISPOSAL MANAGEMENT.** A backyard and commercial piggery, poultry, and other livestock should require a septic tank or proper waste disposal management and must be hygienically observed and implemented.

**SECTION XIII. STOCKADE OF LIVESTOCK.** No animal stockade for the livestock industry shall be maintained and operated within the town proper of the Municipality of Dumalinao. The keeping of any livestock animal intended for butchering in any premises within the town proper for more than five (5) days shall constitute a violation of this section.

Stockade of livestock for trade and/or for breeding shall be allowed only upon securing the necessary sanitary permit, provided that proper sanitary standards are maintained.

**SECTION XIV. USE OF PIGGER, POULTRY, AND LIVESTOCK FARMS.** It shall be unlawful for any person to use the structure of a piggery, whether commercial or backyard or within the premises thereof, as a slaughter area, irrespective of the number of heads.

#### ARTICLE V. ADMINISTRATIVE AND ENFORCEMENT PROVISIONS.

**SECTION XV. MUNICIPAL LIVESTOCK TASK FORCE.** There is hereby created the Municipal Livestock Task Force to be composed of the following:

SECTION XVI. DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES OF MUNICIPAL LIVESTOCK TASK FORCE. The Municipal Livestock Task Force shall have the duties and responsibilities to oversee the implementation of this ordinance, including the

formulation of the Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) for the enforcement of the provision of this ordinance subject to guidelines mandated by national laws.

**SECTION XVII. INSPECTION REPORT.** The Municipal Sanitation Inspector and/or the Barangay Sanitation Inspector shall be primarily tasked with reporting violations of this ordinance to the Municipal Livestock Task Force or the Local Chief Executive.

The Municipal Sanitation Officer may recommend to the Municipal Livestock Task Force or the Local Chief Executive for the closure of the piggery and poultry, whether commercial or backyard, when upon verification:

- a. It continually violates this ordinance despite notice and warning;
- b. Operate without license and permit;
- c. Fail to take corrective action despite notice and warnings;
- d. To closely work and collaborate together in the enforcement of the provision of this ordinance. Further, they shall conduct massive information education and communication campaigns of the provision hereof within one (1) year, after its effectivity.

SECTION XVIII. INVENTORY AND CENSUS. Upon effectivity of this ordinance, the Office of the Municipal Agricultural shall conduct a comprehensive census of all piggery and poultry farms, whether commercial or backyard, in the Municipality of Dumalinao. Such census shall list the facility owner/operator/contract grower (if on lease-contract and duration of the lease), location and area of the farm, number of fowls, heads, swine, and hogs, and an inventory of the existing facilities. Further, the Office of Municipal Agriculture shall keep a record of all livestock animal farms that have been issued permits and registration certificates as well as the renewal thereof.

All piggeries and poultry, whether commercial or backyard, are required to be registered or recorded in the Barangay where they are located.

**SECTION XIX. BABOYANG WALANG AMOY.** All existing or intending to establish, put up, and operate commercial and backyard piggeries shall comply with the method of raising swine referred to as "Baboyang Walang Amoy."

The Office of Municipal Agriculture shall fully implement the Baboyang Walang Amoy and formulate programs and activities for providing rice husk or rice hull to its target beneficiaries.

**SECTION. XX. TRANSITION PERIOD.** There shall be a one (1) year transition period for existing piggery, whether commercial or backyard piggery, to comply with

the Baboyang Walang Amoy. The Office of Municipal Agriculture shall be mandated to organize and train the owners of existing piggeries upon the effectivity of this ordinance. Further, the Office of Municipal Agriculture shall be responsible for disseminating information for applying Baboyang Walang Amoy to new owners intending to establish piggery.

**SECTION XXI. ASSISTANCE FROM PHILIPPINE NATIONAL POLICE.** The MPS-Dumalinao police personnel shall assist in implementing and enforcing violations of this ordinance, including closing the piggery and poultry and imposing penalties.

#### ARTICLE VI. PENAL CLAUSE

**SECTION XXII. PENALTIES AND SANCTIONS.** The following penalties and sanctions shall be imposed for any violation of this Ordinance:

#### a. COMMERCIAL FARMERS

- 1. First Offense is a fine of P1, 000.00 and attend seminar to be conducted by the MENRO and Sanitary Inspector.
- 2. Second Offense is a fine of P2,000.00 and attend seminar to be conducted by the MENRO and Sanitary Inspector.
- 3. Third and Succeeding Offense is a fine of P2, 500.00 and cancellation of permit to operate or an imprisonment of not less than one (1) month or not more than six (6) months, or both at the discretion of the court.

#### **b. BACKYARD FARMERS**

- 1. First Offense is a fine of P500.00 and attend seminar to be conducted by the MENRO and Sanitary Inspector.
- 2. Second Offense is fine of P1,000.00 and attend seminar to be conducted by the MENRO and Sanitary Inspector.
- 3. Third and Succeeding Offense is a fine of P1, 500.00 and cancellation of permit to operate an imprisonment of not less than one (1) month or not more than six (6) months, or both at the discretion of the court.

**SECTION XXIII. OTHER SANCTION.** Any person who shall interfere, hinder or oppose any officer or member of the inspection team of the Municipality of Dumalinao in the performance of their duty in the implementation of this Ordinance or shall tear down, mutilate, deface or alter any billboard, streamer, poster or similar notices affixed to the premises in the enforcement of this Ordinance shall be guilty of misdemeanor and is punishable, upon conviction, by imprisonment of not more than six (6) months, or a fine of not less than Two

Thousand Five Hundred Pesos (P2,500.00), or both upon the discretion of the court.

**SECTION XXIV. IMPLEMENTING AUTHORITY.** The MENRO and Sanitary Inspector are hereby mandated as the lead agency tasked with implementing and enforcing this Ordinance. For this purpose, they may enlist the support of the Business Permit and Licensing Section, Municipal Treasurer's Office, Philippine National Police, and any other government agency as they may deem necessary.

**SECTION XXV. PROHIBITED TRANSACTION.** No local government employee shall be allowed to transact directly with any establishment to facilitate the issuance of Health Certification and Business Permits.

**SECTION XXVI. APPLICABILITY OF SANITATION CODE OF THE PHILIPPINES AND OTHER LAWS.** The Sanitation Code of the Philippines, the Ecological Solid Waste Management Act of 2000, the Clean Air Act, the Clean Water Act, their Implementing Rules and Regulations, and other laws shall apply to all matters not provided in this Ordinance.

**SECTION XXVII. NO CONTEST PROVISION.** Any person, individual, or entity who is apprehended or cited for the violation and who does not wish to contest the violation and is willing to pay voluntarily the fine imposed upon him/her prior to the filing of formal charges with the proper court shall be allowed to pay said fine to the Municipal Treasurer within seventy-two (72) hours from apprehension to avoid being criminally prosecuted; otherwise, the case shall be prosecuted.

**SECTION XXVIII. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE.** If for any purpose, any part or provision of this Ordinance shall be held unconstitutional or invalid, other parts or provisions thereof not affected shall continue to be in full and effect.

**SECTION XXIX. REPEALING CLAUSE.** All Ordinances and Administrative circulars and executive orders, or part thereof that are found to be inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed or amended accordingly.

**SECTION XI. EFFECTIVITY.** This Ordinance shall take effect upon review and approval.

EXCERPTS FROM THE MINUTES OF THE PUBLIC HEARING OF THE PROPOSED ORDINANCES OF THE 12<sup>TH</sup> SANGGUNIANG BAYAN OF DUMALINAO, ZAMBOANGA DEL SUR ON JANUARY 19, 2024, HELD AT MUNICIPAL GYMNASIUM, DUMALINAO ZAMBOANGA DEL SUR.

#### A. OPENING SESSION.



Parila presented the proposed ordinance, prescribing proper management, containment and control of African Swine Fever (ASF) in the Municipality of Dumalinao, Zamboanga del Sur, imposing penalties for violations and appropriating funds thereof and explained the purpose and importance of the guidelines and implementation of African Swine Fever (ASF) in the locality, which is to avoid highly contagious viral disease of swine.



- 8. Hon. Romeo D. Parila presented the proposed ordinance preserving and promoting the indigenous culture and arts in the Municipality of Dumalinao, Zamboanga del Sur, providing funds thereof.
- 9. Hon. Jelito R. Peñonal presented the proposed ordinance requiring all businesses, commercial complexes, and establishments considered as high risk to install Close Circuit Television (CCTV) camera and providing penalties for violation thereof. According to Hon. Jelito R. Peñonal the purpose of this ordinance is to help and prevent the occurrence of the crime rate in the locality and to ensure the public with regards to the safety of the community.
- 10. Hon. Romeo G. Ligan presented the proposed ordinance declaring and establishing the Four Hundred Thirty-Nine Thousand Six Hundred (439,600) square meters coastal area of Zone 1 as Mangrove Protected Area, providing funds and penalties for the purpose thereof.
- 11. Hon. Hermes B. Cabales presented the proposed ordinance regulating the activities of the Youth and Minors of the Municipality of Dumalinao, Province of Zamboanga del Sur, requiring them to be in their respective residence on or before 9:00 PM to 5:00 AM except for emergencies and justifiable causes, providing penalties for violation thereof and for other purposes.
- 12. Hon. Romeo G. Ligan discussed the proposed ordinance establishing and providing measures for the beautification, development, maintenance, and management of the Municipal Park and Plaza in the Municipality of Dumalinao, Zamboanga del Sur.
- 13. Hon. Romeo D. Parila deliberated the proposed ordinance regulating the operations of commercial and backyard piggery, poultry, and other livestock in the Municipality of Dumalinao, Zamboanga del Sur, providing penalties and for other purposes.

#### C. OPEN FORUM.

Mrs. Jenelyn Daal from Purok 1 questioned in 2 years wala ko kadawat sa 4P's, ang akung pangutana asa napaingun ang funding nga dapat akung makuha. Hon. Ma. Gemma C. Albiso replied nga e-refer sa local 4P's office for clarification and guidance.

Hon. Romeo P. Aranas, Barangay Kagawad of Rebokon raised a question Pananglitan ang mga tawo sa evacuation center, ang baroy ug madasigun nga

naa sa upper portion, pwede bana nato sila ma mapugos nga apil gihapon sila if ever nga mo evacuate.

Pugson, jud na sila kay wa ta kabalo ang kana nga upper portion maapektaran sa tsunami, Hon. Jelito R. Peñonal replied.

Hon. Romeo P. Aranas suggested if ever nga dile jud nato sila mapugos, pwede ba nga akung isugyot nga under-monitoring sila for safety.

Hon. Jelito R. Peñonal said yes sir pwede ra.

Hon. Jonmar Rapel, Barangay Kagawad of Rebokon asked with regards sa area covered sa 4.36 hectares nga Mangrove Protected Area, asa dapit ang area covered sa Pantad to Baroy? Beside sa fishpond, covered batong area-ha sa 4.26 hectares? Kay naa rabay uban nga ilang balikon og open katong mga abandoned fishpond, kana nga mga fishpond covered bana sa LGU.

Hon. Romeo G. Ligan answered koralon ang area nga sakop sa 4.36 hectares, then basta abandoned fishpond, mo inspection pa ang DENR kabahin ana ug naa pai again nga mga legal nga process.

Hon. Jonmar Rapel questioned if kanang mga fishpond nga naa sa front area, apil ba gihapon nasa protected area? Then kanang mga protected area pwede bana nato botngan og fishpond.

Hon. Romeo G. Ligan answered nga eagi pa sa process sa pagdeclare nga abandon nga ang maong fishpond.

#### D. CLOSING REMARKS.

A closing remarks was given to Hon. Jonmar Rapel the Barangay Kagawad of Rebokon, Dumalinao, Zamboanga del Sur.
