RESOLUTION NO. 072-2022

RECOMMENDING TO THE LOCAL INTER-AGENCY TASK FORCE COUNCIL OF DUMALINAO, ZAMBOANGA DEL SUR OF THE REQUEST OF SUMADAT ELEMENTARY SCHOOL, ALLOWING THEM TO PARTICIPATE IN THE PROGRESSIVE EXPANSION PHASE LIMITED FACE TO FACE CLASSES FOR THE SCHOOL YEAR 2022-2023.

WHEREAS, presented for consideration and appropriate action is the request of Mr. Neil D. Sarsalejo, School Principal of Sumadat Elementary School to allow them to participate in the Progressive Expansion Phase Limited Face to Face Classes for the School Year 2022-2023;

WHEREAS, Section 16 of Republic Act 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, provides that every Local Government Unit shall exercise power expressly granted those necessarily implied therefrom, as well as powers necessary, appropriate, or incidental for its efficient and effective governance, and those which are essential to the promotion of the general welfare;



WHEREAS, the participating schools shall secure a clearance from the Local Government Unit on the holding of face to face classes and comply with the standards of the School Safety Assessment Tool (SSAT);

WHEREAS, Sumadat Elementary School is requesting an ocular inspection of their classroom and school premises in order to validate the requirements set by the concerned departments, primarily, Department of Education and Department of Health, and the readiness of the said school;

WHEREAS, this august body acknowledge the importance of the Progressive Expansion Phase Limited Face to Face Classes and at the same time the health and safety of the students and teachers;

WHEREAS, after careful review and exhaustive deliberation, and after finding the same to be proper and order;

NOW, THEREFORE, premises above-considered, on motion by **HON. JESSIE NIEL C. PAULO** the body resolved, as it hereby resolves to recommend to the Local Inter-Agency Task Force (LIATF) of Dumalinao, Zamboanga del Sur of the request of Sumadat Elementary School, allowing them to participate in the Progressive Expansion Phase Limited Face to Face Classes for the School Year 2022-2023 .
